**A Sneak Preview of *lady in the red dress*, a Dark Comedy about Revenge -
Opening Jan 29th, 2009**

TORONTO, ON - Enjoy the first of a series of trailers for *lady in the red dress* - the exciting new production from fu-GEN, Asian-Canadian Theatre Company. Opening just after Chinese New Year at the end of January, *lady in the red dress* sets out to address issues of Asian-Canadian's societal roles and identities, specifically the 2006 Chinese-Canadian redress for the Head Tax Exclusion Act of 1923. A stylistic fusion of author Haruki Murakami and graphic novelist Frank Miller, it is the story of a lawyer without a conscience, a woman without a past, and vengeance for a cause that has been ignored too long. A darkly comic revenge story about the skeletons in our closets, and the consequences of our (in)actions.
